- Honour and support the efforts of fellow volunteers
- Communicate honestly and fully with others
- Be inclusive to people regardless of race, origin, sex, religion or disability
- Not be involved in criminal activities
- Encourage young people to become involved
- Refrain from public criticism of fellow volunteers, members and staff
- Be friendly and welcoming to new members
- Not abuse alcohol or drugs
- Refrain from profane, insulting, harassing or otherwise offensive language in the conduct of my volunteer duties
- Encourage non-victims to become involved and to play a key role in your Chapter
- Be honest and trustworthy
- Respect one another's opinions even if they differ from your own
- Respect the privacy of others
- Respect and adhere to MADD Canada policies and guidelines that relate to volunteer activity and the program I serve
- Refrain from using my MADD Canada volunteer status for personal or business financial gain
- Refrain from wearing inappropriate clothing when representing MADD Canada
- Show up on time for volunteer commitments
